Use of Adobe Photoshop & Premiere to develop a story from a theme, script and storyboard it, prepare backgrounds, sound effects, film and edit and then produce posters to advertise the film using Photoshop

The workshop will include:

- **Ideas & Concepts setting up of a production team. Initial exploration and development of ideas for a film theme**
- **Film & Edit using Sony A1E HD cameras and capture into Adobe Premiere CS4 in preparation for editing adding sound effects and voiceover**
- **Use Adobe Photoshop CS4 to design & produce posters to advertise the film**
