'Simply ICT'

really basic camera skills, image manipulation, video editing and frame-based animation

After school courses for teachers who have little experience in filming, video editing or using Flash to create animations

Various dates between 6th October and 16th December. All sessions run after school 4 to 5pm.

Each course can be booked independently of each other.

Each 'Simply ICT' courses *comprises:*

Simple Flash, 6th, 13th **AND** 20th October – From clicking Start->All Programs->Adobe->Flash this three week course will cover the Flash toolbox and drawing tools, making a simple frame-based animation, the timeline, key frames and motion tweening to create smooth animations.



Simple Photoshop, 2nd, 9th **AND** 23rd November – A basic introduction to Adobe Photoshop this three week course will cover the common Photoshop tools and techniques, image adjustment, text, filters and an introduction to layers.

Simple Camera Skills, 15th **AND** 18th November – Familiarise yourself with good quality cameras and tripods, practise camera angles and film techniques then book out a camera kit to do your own filming in school. Camera skills... 'Done!'

Simple Video Editing, 2nd, 9th **AND** 16th December – A really basic introduction to Adobe Premiere covering simple editing skills, titles, sound and music. Why not come on the camera skills workshop, borrow camera kit to film your own footage and then come back to edit it?

It is expected that teachers attend all sessions of the courses they have chosen.



Adobe Flash is commonly used to create cartoon-style animations and interactive web pages. It is also used to design online applications, games and content for mobile phones.

Capture, edit and deliver video online, on air, on disc or on device. Adobe Premiere Pro is a start-to-finish high quality video production solution that is an industry standard.

Adobe Photoshop is considered the industry standard in most visual arts jobs. It is very strong in the world of printed media and is popular with newspapers, magazines and other publishers.
